The following **<u>RESOLUTIONS</u>** were passed:

- 1. Approval of the **Minutes** of the 19th Regional Conference held in Krakow (Poland) on 4 June 2019.
- 2. Approval of the Admission of the cities of Icheri Sheher (Azerbaijan) and Cáceres (Spain), and the departure of the city of Provins (France), meaning that the Secretariat will comprise 32 cities during 2021.
- 3. Approval of the 2020 Management Report.
- 4. Approval of the **2020 Financial Report**, with income of €50,840.69 and expenditure of €17,359.98, leaving a surplus of €33,480.71.
- 5. Approval of the theme for the **Day of Solidarity** for 2021, which will be "Quality of Life in the Historic Centres".
- 6. Approval of the **Arts and Crafts Project** in 2021, to be coordinated by the city of Évora (Portugal) (€5,000).
- 7. Approval of the **3rd Young Ambassadors' Encounter** with the same theme as the World Congress (Enhancing Livability in World Heritage Cities) to be held in the city of **Évora** (Portugal), the date in 2021 yet to be determined. (€10,750).
- 8. Approval of the **3rd Artistic Expression Competition** in 2021. (€1,500).
- 9. Approval of the **Tastes of the World Heritage Cities Project** in 2021. (€5,500).
- 10. Approval of the "Quality of Life in the Historic Centres" Project with various webinars on this subject to be held throughout 2021. (€7,500)
- 11. Termination of the **Mobility Project**.
- 12. Keeping the **Tourism Project** on standby during 2021.
- 13. Keeping the Visual Decontamination Project on standby during 2021.
- 14. Approval of the **2021 Budget** with a total of \notin 56,480.71.
- 15. Election of the city of **Mostar** (Bosnia-Herzegovina) as host of the **Projects Meeting**, the date in 2021 yet to be determined.
- **16.** Election of the city of **Elvas** (Portugal) as host of the **21**st **Regional Conference**, the date in 2021 yet to be determined.
- **17.** Unanimous approval of the **Renewal of Córdoba as the home city of the Regional Secretariat.**
