Corona Emergency Programme Regensburg (CNPR) to mitigate the economic consequences of the pandemic for artists, authors and publicists

To mitigate the economic consequences of the corona pandemic especially for artists and publicists, the city of Regensburg is setting up a Regensburg Corona Emergency Programme (CNPR) in addition to the existing emergency aid programmes of the Bavarian State Government and the Federal Government.

The Corona Emergency Programme Regensburg (CNPR) supports freelance artists and publicists particularly affected by the corona pandemic, as well as cultural associations, with grants. Through a rather uncomplicated and easy-to-apply procedure, quick support directly through the city's Cultural Department is granted. A monthly subsidy of up to 1.000 Euro can be granted for up to 3 months (and to be extended if crisis continues).

Regensburg wishes to make sure that an especially active and diverse cultural scene of individual artists can survive this crisis and re-start soon to enrich all our lives.
